**The Executive Stakeholders Committee (ESC)** is comprised of representatives in a manner that achieves balanced representation of Primary Stakeholders from the radon community. The ESC shall include a voting delegate and, if available, an alternate voting delegate for each of approximately 9-11 stakeholder interest groups. Duties include:

- Establishing and continually revising operating procedures for creating AARST National Radon Standards
- Establishing priorities for standards action
- Establishing multiple subcommittees tasked with each individual standard action
- Auditing resulting documents for assurance of due process and procedures as defined in Articles 6.3.2 and 6.3.3 of the Consortium Bylaws
- Ensuring coordination and harmonization including good faith efforts to resolve potential conflicts between existing American National Standards and candidate American National Standards

**The Standards Management Council (SMC)** is comprised of elected officials and individuals appointed by the AARST Board and shall direct certain operations and facilitate internal and external relations for the AARST Consortium on National Radon Standards.

The SMC shall be the central contact and authority for:

- Budgets and funding
- Publication and distribution of documents
- Audits prior to publication as defined in Consortium Bylaws Article 6.3 *Review and Audits*, and in accordance with Annex F *Internal Auditing*
- Resolving disputes that are outside the scope of responsibilities otherwise defined herein for consensus bodies including certain duties stipulated in Annex
